Personal Hygiene Pack

| 1 washcloth | 1 hand towel |
| 1 bottle shampoo (11—14 oz) | 1 comb or brush |
| 1 bottle skin lotion (11—14 oz) | 1 deodorant |
| 1 bath-size bar of soap | 2 disposable razors |
| 1 fluoride toothpaste, 6 oz. or more | 1 toothbrush in original, unopened pkg. |

Tighten lids and place all items in a **large zip lock bag (2-gallon size works best)**. Place zip locks in boxes labeled "**Personal Hygiene Pack.**" Please also mark the **quantity** on the outside of **each box**.
